- have a permanent residence in the Dallas-Fort Worth area.

- be pursuing a career in the communications industry such as broadcast, print, advertising, public relations, photojournalism, graphic arts, video production, and film
- have a 2.5 overall grade-point average
- attend or have a representative in attendance at the annual Hispanic Communicators awards banquet.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Official transcripts from high school or all colleges you have attended. No copies will be accepted. (Official transcripts can take time to process. It is important that you request them as soon as possible so that we can receive them before the October 18th deadline.)
- 2. Complete the Scholarship Application Form. All questions must be answered with correct information.
- 3. A 250-word typed autobiography explaining why you are a good candidate to receive the scholarship and your need for financial assistance.
- 4. A 250-word essay answering the following question "What is the most important issue facing the Latino community? How will you use the communications field to help with that issue?
- 5. Three samples of your work (clips, video or audiotapes, etc.). All samples must be submitted electronically. Please make sure your name is on each item. Do not submit original work. Items will not be returned.
- 6. Distribute three recommendation forms, which must be e-mailed directly to the Hispanic Communicators
- 7. D/FW from the person recommending the student. Select respondents who can attest to your academic ability, journalistic abilities and personal qualities. One recommendation should be from your professor, teacher or immediate supervisor.
- 8. Color digital photograph (to be used during banquet program).
- 9. Once winners are selected and notified, recipients must submit a short video about themselves (Once you are selected we will provide further direction).
